# CLIMATIC CONDITIONS

The 2016 climatic year was composed of two distinct parts. First, a cool and wet spring with record rainfall (259 mm from April to June, compared to 108 mm during the same period in 2015). A short break from the rain in May allowed for a quick and even flowering. The weather shifted in mid-June, giving way to clear skies and warm temperatures. The vegetative cycle slowed over the summer months, but rain in mid-September allowed the grapes to reach full maturity.

# TASTING NOTE

JEAN-PIERRE MOUEIX BORDEAUX 2016 is a brilliant crimson red. The nose expresses subtle nuances of strawberry, licorice, spice and forest floor. On the palate the wine is supple with well-integrated tannins. The long and fresh finish is dominated by red fruit notes.
